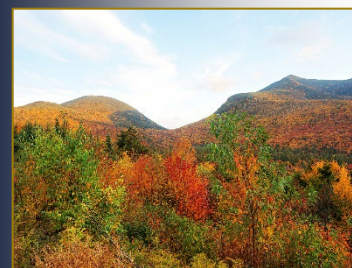


# Orange Community Master Chorale Fall Foliage Performance Tour to Vermont, Massachusetts, Pennsylvania & Washington, DC

Visit Arlington National Cemetery and view a special wreath-laying ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier (School/Government Issued ID required for entry for 16 years and older)  
5:00pm Dinner at Fish Market  
Spend time in Old Town Alexandria Waterfront  
Check-in to the SpringHill Suites Alexandria Town/Southwest



**Day 9      Wednesday, October 25      Washington, DC      (B,D)**

Breakfast at the hotel  
9:00am Visit Ford's Theater, where Lincoln was shot, and the Peterson House, where Lincoln passed away  
11:15am Visit the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum  
Lunch, on own  
1:30pm Arrive at the Fairfax  
**2:30pm *Concert for military veterans at the Fairfax at Belvoir Woods***  
Evening dinner at a local restaurant  
Enjoy an evening walking tour of the Lincoln, Vietnam, Korean, Franklin Delano Roosevelt, and National World War II Memorials, as well as a view of the outside of the Washington Monument  
Return to the hotel for overnight

**Day 10      Thursday, October 26      Washington, DC      (B)**

Breakfast at the hotel, followed by check-out:  
Tour one or more of the Smithsonian Institution Museums  
Lunch, on own
